I have developed and written films, television, and limited-series – both for myself and for-hire. My education and history as an actor gave me a focus on character driven stories, while dragging two indie features from the written page to distribution (and every step in between) developed my pragmatic view of what is physically and financially possible to achieve within a producer's means.

I've pitched to major studios and production companies including **MGM, FOX, AMC, Miramax, Wonder St, Zero Gravity, G-Unit, Valhalla, Screen Arcade, Medina Co., and more.**

I've run a writer's room for a 9-episode, hour-long drama with **Blair Underwood** and **Octavia Spencer** attached, which is currently being shopped by *Wonder St.*

I've navigated a room of **Sony / Capcom** executives who hired me for **Resident Evil: Vendetta** to make an English translation of a Japanese script sound like the characters were American.

I've screened shorts and features at dozens of small to mid-sized festivals, and my writing has advanced in a number of competitions including the **Austin Film Festival** where I was a **Humanitas Award** Finalist.

Currently, I'm prepping a fully financed feature I wrote and am producing, which stars and will be directed by *Blair Underwood.*

I'm ready to pitch scripts and stories I've already written, as well as those that are still only ideas, but just as importantly, I'm ready to get excited about *your* film, *your* show, *your* article, *your* idea and to work with you to create something amazing.

I gravitate toward drama that makes a person think. If there happens to be a dash of history, or a twist of science fiction, I'm beyond stoked. I excel with stories that require a deep dive, research, and/or have multitudes of moving pieces, but I keep focused on how the world affects characters.
